RECREATION COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS
FEBRUARY 11, 2025

The Recreation Committee meeting was called to order by Chairman Chris Gunderson at the Weyauwega Municipal Building Council Chambers at 6:10 pm. Roll call was taken. Members Present: Chris Gunderson, Austin Baehnman and Citizen Member Andy Rosenwinkel. Not Present: Vacant Alderman seat, Citizen Members DeAnna Volz, Tim Potratz and new member Lauren Wisner. No quorum present. Also Present: Mayor Rich Luedke, Clerk Rebecca Loehrke, Meta Berg, Shani Appleby, Pat Gorchals, Brian Doherty, Dewey Stelzner, Tom Cullen, Dan Nehring, and Lori Gosz.

The January 14, 2025 meeting minutes will be approved at the next committee meeting.

Citizen Appearances: Dewey Stelzner gave an update on the July 3rd fireworks celebration. The DJ is willing to donate his time and equipment for music that night. Stelzner has spoken with Frankie Moscato. She is willing to come but would like to do a 2-hour concert for \$700. Stelzner said not really interested in a two hour show at this time.

Appointment of Citizen Member to Recreation Committee: Lauren Wisner was planning to come to tonight's meeting but ended up being ill. The Mayor will appoint her to the Recreation Committee at the February Council meeting.

WF Youth Baseball/Softball Updates – Brian Doherty: Doherty went over a power point on the options for dugouts and team benches. Dugouts with chain link fencing will be approximately \$10,000 with the city paying for half. The group is looking to go with the chain link fence with a shade. The shade cover would need to be removed and stored in the off season. The club has funding available now. This design would allow for future permanent shade projects if desired. Doherty also presented options for benches in the dugouts. The existing benches are rusted out and falling apart. Looking at either a basic aluminum bench with back or a composite desking material seat and back. The composite style would need to be stored in the winter. Will have final design to committee by next month. Doherty also noted that the net in the batting cages will be hung up in March/April and the electrical work for the scoreboard will be done this spring.
