Discussion and possible action on Ordinance 2024-3 establishing a Food Truck Ordinance: Corrections were made that were discussed at the last committee meeting. Let her know if anything should be changed or added. *Motion Berg, second Appleby, to approve Ordinance 2024-3 Regulations of Mobile Food Establishments. Motion carried with all "ayes".*

Discussion on All-Terrain Vehicle Ordinance – Chapter 454, Article VI: Appleby has discussed a change to our current ATV/UTV ordinance with the Police Chief. She would like to see that a driver would need to have a valid driver's license in order to operate in the City limits. The state does not require it but each municipality can make the ordinance stricter. It will not be the sole reason to pull someone over but will be another violation to add if they would get pulled over. The clerk will make the necessary changes to the ordinance and bring back to the committee for final review in October.

Discussion on removing Administrator Position from the City's Code Book: With the decision to not hire an Administrator it has been discussed what needs to be changed in our ordinance book. Gosz suggested the positon be left in the book but not fill the position because it could change in the future. Committee asked the Clerk to check with Attorney Kalny to see if anything needs to be done in the code book.
