

PROCEEDINGS OF THE SPECIAL COMMON COUNCIL  
CITY OF WEYAUWEGA  
MONDAY, OCTOBER 28, 2024

The special meeting of the Common Council of the City of Weyauwega was called to order at 4:00 p.m., on Monday, October 28, 2024 by Mayor Rich Luedke in the Weyauwega Municipal Building Council Chambers.

Roll Call: Present: Mayor Rich Luedke, Meta Berg, Pat Gorchals, Austin Baehnman, Shani Appleby, and Chris Gunderson. Not Present: Cameron Looker. Others Present: Police Chief Brandon Leschke, Treasurer Trina Herbst-Gutche, Lori Gosz, Frank Zabojski and Kelly Kneisler. Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Luedke.

2025 Budget Draft Review: Lori Gosz, McMahon Associates, went over the 2025 Proposed General Fund at \$1,781,429 which is -2.9% from 2024 budget. She moved the Library to a separate Library Fund which should not have been included in the General Fund. Also a Special Revenue Fund for the Cemetery was set up. There was discussion on splitting of funds. The allowable Levy Limit for the City is \$1,047,449. If the City levied this full allowable amount the tax rate would be \$8.05. The proposed levy presented to council has a levy amount of \$1,027,075 which would put the City tax rate at \$7.89. *Motion Gunderson, second Appleby, to approve the proposed 2025 General Budget levy at \$1,027,075. Motion carried with all "ayes".* The proposed budget summary will be sent to the paper for publication in the October 31<sup>st</sup> and November 7<sup>th</sup> issues of the Waupaca County Post. The Public Hearing will be held at the November 18<sup>th</sup> Council meeting.
