Discussion and possible action on Ordinance 2024-3 establishing Food Truck Ordinance:

Also add under 455-5 (E) a sentence that states unless approved by City Administration (to operate in a public park). Went over some of the samples of applications that were in the meeting packet. Committee liked areas of each one so will combine them into our application. Would like to have an area for the property owner to sign approving the food truck to be on their property. Clerk Loehrke will also inform Jim Nehring at the Fire Department who is the Chief Deputy Inspector that they will receive calls for inspections.
