PUBLIC HEALTH AND RELIEF (ORDINANCE) COMMITTEE MEETING PROCEEDINGS

**Discussion and possible action on Ordinance 2024-3 establishing a Food Truck Ordinance:**

Rennie spoke on the concerns and questions that Attorney Kalny has on the ordinance wording that was submitted to him. Attorney Kalny has said that there are a lot of lawsuits around the state involving food trucks. Gunderson would like to know where the lawsuits took place and what the outcome was from them. Committee is still good with being 150 feet away from local food establishments. Need to make sure the definition is for a licensed mobile food unit. Committee is good with a \$100 yearly fee. The trucks would need to follow signage ordinance for the B-1 General Business Zoning district. No outside tables for customers. Rennie will prepare an application. Attorney Kalny will need to make corrections to what was originally submitted to him and put together in the proper ordinance format to be approved at the next committee meeting. Found out on Facebook about a food truck going to Maasch Park on August 6<sup>th</sup> but no one has been in contact with the truck yet.

**Set next meeting date and time:** The next committee meeting will be held Monday, July 8, 2024 immediately following the Recreation Committee Meeting.

**Such Other Matters as Authorized by Law:** Appleby brought up about dogs in the Cemetery. She would like to discuss at the next meeting ordinance 190-12. She said what the ordinance states is different than what is listed on the sign for the cemetery. Will put on the agenda for July.
